<p>Communication Protocol Who Should I Call When I Have a Concern?</p> <p>Education is a shared experience, involving the home and the school, and it can be strengthened through open communication. If a parent, guardian or stakeholder has a concern about a school matter, the following procedures for review of the issue are available:</p> <p>Step 1: Contact the classroom teacher/staff member to resolve the matter. It is important to maintain regular contact with the school throughout the year.</p> <p>Step 2: If the situation has not been resolved, contact the school Principal. The Principal will review the issues and work to resolve the matter as quickly as possible.</p> <p>Step 3: If the situation has not yet been resolved, contact the Superintendent in charge of the school involved. The Superintendent will review the matter and will respond to the parents/guardian/stakeholder about their concerns. Call (705) 673-5620 for contact information.</p> <p>Step 4: If the situation has not yet been resolved, contact the Director of Education to have the matter reviewed.
