About Co-Op:

Students who have secured a summer job in the community can earn up to two credits through our traditional delivery of the summer co-op program. Students are responsible for finding their own placements, and will be required to log their hours at work and complete assignments, as administered and assessed by the summer cooperative education teacher.

Who can apply:

Grade 11 students who have arranged for their own placement this upcoming summer. Grade 10 students entering Grade 11 are also eligible, provided they have been pre-registered as a SHSM student or have found an opportunity to be registered or participating in the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP). Some restrictions apply. Please note that guidance counsellors or cooperative education teachers are not responsible for securing placements for students this summer, with the possible exception of potential OYAP placements within the community.

Pates and Times:

Mandatory Online Pre-placement: May 29th to June 30th, 2023

In preparation for their community at-work placements, students are required to complete online pre-placement activities (roughly 20 hours) during the month of June. Students are required to attend a mandatory online orientation session hosted by the summer coop instructor on Monday, May 29th from 6:00pm to 8:30pm. An email will be sent to all registered students prior to the session with instruction to log-on.

Placement Dates: July 4th to August 4th, 2023

Students are expected to log and submit their placement hours (roughly 184 hours for two credits), and will need to log in periodically to complete the required integration and culminating activities, as assigned by the co-operative education instructor.
