"THAT the method of processing cheques through automated signing and the control of the electronic signature file be as recommended by our auditors."	
"THAT the Chairperson and the Executive Superintendent of Business and Finance and Treasurer of the Board are hereby authorized to borrow sums as required from the Scotiabank to meet current expenditures of the Board until the provincial grants have been received and to pay or agree to pay interest on the sum so borrowed at	

the prime rate of interest or better. The max one time is to be no more than ten million do differently by resolution of the Board."
