# COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL WHO SHOULD I CALL WHEN I HAVE A CONCERN?

Education is a shared experience, involving the home and the school, and is strengthened through open communication. If a parent, guardian or stakeholder has a concern about a school matter, the following procedures should be followed:

Step 1: Contact the classroom teacher/staff member to resolve the matter. It is important to maintain regular contact with the school throughout the year.

Step 2: If the situation has not been resolved, contact the school Principal.

Step 3: If the situation has not yet been resolved, contact the Superintendent who supervises the school. The Superintendent will review the matter. Call (705) 673-5620 for contact information or visit www.sudburycatholicschools.ca.

Step 4: If the situation has not resolved, contact the Director of Education to have the matter reviewed. You may also wish to contact your local Trustee if the matter remains unresolved.
