## Description:

In preparation for the start of the school year, staff will revisit the Duty to Accommodate, with a focus on supporting the diverse strengths and needs of all learners. Professional learning will explore a variety of instructional, assessment, and evaluation strategies, with particular attention to Universal Design for Learning (UDL) and creating inclusive and responsive learning environments.

Staff will also renew their commitment to Catholic education, exploring Catholic resources and practices that support student well-being, belonging, and a positive transition back to school.

Secondary staff will review updates to Ontario's assessment and evaluation policies and graduation requirements, including changes related to final evaluations and financial literacy. Staff will also receive information about updated curriculum expectations and provincial educational resources available to support teaching and learning.

School teams will also engage in student achievement planning and review individual student needs and transition information to help ensure appropriate supports are in place as students begin the new school year.
